


#### How to get Sci-Hub tokens

using mobile Phantom wallet


This instruction explains how to get Sci-Hub tokens using mobile Phantom wallet as an example. Tokens are used to support Sci-Hub and open science, as well as to request new papers on a Sci-Net platform.





Let's start by installing the Phantom wallet application to your mobile device:

phantom.com/download




You will need to top up Solana to your wallet. A 8 USD equivalent of SOL will be enough.

# what if Solana top up did not work?

In most cases, you will be able to buy Solana tokens directly from inside the wallet using credit card or some local e-money provider, depending on the country. This is the most straightforward way, but it can have some disadvantages: not working in all countries; if it works, you might be asked to do identity verification by providing the scan of your passport / government ID.

In the latter case, your data will not be collected by Sci-Hub, and will be available only to the exchanger service that sells Solana. This service will not know that you're buying Solana for Sci-Hub. In other words, providing documents is secure, but if you're still uncomfortable with it, you can go a more complicated way as well (see Appendix)

Now you will need to swap your Solana tokens to Sci-Hub tokens...

Open the web browser and navigate to:

sci-net.xyz/exchange




### SOL → SCI

automatic exchange of Solana to Sci-Hub tokens

How it works: simply send Solana to the following address, and get equivalent number of Sci-Hub tokens back. The minimum amount to send is 0.023 SOL, which is roughly equal to 9 tokens







In the Phantom app, press Send button












Press this small square button. A QR code scanner will appear. Scan the QR code on the exchanger website that you opened in Step 2






After the QR code is scanned, a screen to send tokens will appear.

Press this button and send the tokens to the exchanger






If you did everything correctly, you will see the Success screen.

Now close this screen.








#### refresh

A recent
activity screen
will appear. Now
you can wait for
a couple of
minutes, then
refresh the page
(by sliding the
screen down)


Note: this step is not **required** — just to confirm...



If you did everything right, you will see Sci-Hub tokens were sent to your wallet.

Congratulations!






Open the web browser and navigate to sci-net.xyz/invite Click the QR button and wait for the code to appear

In the Phantom app, press Send button

Scan the QR code on the website. After a couple minutes, an invite code will appear.





#### appendix

top up Solana from external platform

To top up wallet from another platform, you will need to get the wallet address. Click Receive button to view wallet addresses





Click **Copy** icon to copy the Solana wallet address. In this example, the address is starting from **CHfm...** 

Top up the copied address using an alternative platform or exchange available in your country.

If access to the platform is blocked, try opening the website with a VPN browser extension.

Then proceed to the Step 2 of the instruction.
